## Dear Mr. Knight:

Enclosed are the renewed Part 373 Hazardous Waste Management and air Title V Facility permits for the Cohoes Norlite Facility as referenced above. The permits become effective January 1, 2016 and expire December 31, 2020.

Also enclosed is a responsiveness summary providing the Department's response to comments received on the draft Part 373 permit and any changes made to the draft permit. Please note that while the Department did not receive comments from the public on the draft Title V permit renewal during the public comment period for that application, questions related to the facility Title V permit and or air emissions submitted during the Part 373 review have been addressed in this responsiveness summary.

Please note, the issued air Title V facility permit includes a change from the draft permit to address comment from the US EPA. US EPA requested the operating parameter limits (OPL) for minimum pressure drop on the venture scrubber, permit limit of 2.93 inches of water column in the draft/proposed permit, be revised to reflect the pressure drop established and currently in effect under the MACT from the April 2011 Notice of Compliance submitted by Norlite. The Department has agreed with the request from US EPA and the issued permit has a minimum pressure drop for the venture scrubber referenced in permit conditions 101 and 115 of 6.1 inches of water column.

Please have the permits and responsiveness summary posted to the Norlite website by January 11, 2016.

Should you object to the permits as issued and are unable to resolve such objections with this office, you may, within 30 calendar days of transmittal, send a request for hearing to the attention of the Regional Permit Administrator.
