

Environmental Benefits Projects

Norlite has funded 2 Environmental Benefits Projects (EBP) in coordination with agreements with New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (NYSDEC) for the benefit of the City of Cohoes. The administration of the EBP funds is the responsibility of the City of Cohoes.

2011 Projects - \$35,000 funded by Norlite

- The City of Cohoes will purchase and place recycling bins in city parks and city schools.
- The City School District will appoint a designated Recycling Coordinator, develop "Green Teams", promote paper recycling at the schools, and promote recycling education at the schools.
- The Cohoes Housing Authority will purchase and install energy efficiency storm and prime doors for the Saratoga Sites Housing Complex.
- The City of Cohoes will promote recycling efforts throughout the community with marketing programs via the Web, mailings, posters, and other communications media.

2014 Projects - \$64,000 funded by Norlite

- Funds to be used by the Cohoes Fire Department for the purchase of 10 Scot Air Paks.
- Funds to be used by the City of Cohoes for the purchase of 2 electric cars for general use.
